ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN DURING THE YEAR 2018-19

SENIOR CITIZENS' HOME:

The Integrated Rural Upliftment Service (IRUS) has been running Senior Citizen's Home at Sagang, Churachandpur District, Manipur under the financial assistance from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi vide sanction letter No. 15-14(20)/2015-16-Sr.C.I since 1st April, 2018. The project is converted into Senior Citizens' Home for 25 Senior Citizens from Multi Service Centre for 50 older persons. Through the centre, 25 senior citizens are getting benefit in a broad spectrum services by providing fooding, shelter, clothing, recreation, regular medical check-up, yoga, companionship and outings. The beneficiaries also produced income generating works by making agarbati and the income of elder persons are generated for their self expenditure.

DRUG ABUSE AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

The organisation had organised one day drug abuse awareness programme on 10th June, 2018 at Thoubal Kiyam, Thoubal District, Manipur. During the programme, the resource persons from the concerned department took delivered on the preventive measures of the drug and important of undertaken alternative programmes of vocational training is so much for recovery addict to sustain in normal life. Many problems which were created from different angle in the society can be resolved. 80 youths, local leaders, club, meira paibis, students were participated in the programme.

WOMEN AND CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMME:

The organisation has organised 1 day free medical camp for women and children at Kiyam Makha Leikai, Thoubal District on 15th July, 2018. About 110 campers comprising women and children participated in the camp. The camp was jointly organised with Kiyam Welfare Club.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME:



Food Processing and Preservation Training:



During the training programme, the organisation has engaged 2 instructors who gave theory and practical classes on Food Processing/Preservation.

Women and Child Welfare Programme:

Free Health Camp:

The organisation was organized 1 day Free Health Camp at Kiyam, Thoubal District, Manipur on 3rd October, 2017 in association with PHC, Kiyam. Altogether 125 women and children took part in the camp. Free medicines were also distributed to the campers.
